



2021 2-Man Cruiser Rules

General: *These rules and regulations are designed to govern driver and crew member conduct during GSS racing events. By participating in these events, all drivers are required to comply with these rules. While GSS makes no claim of guaranteed safety, these rules are enforced as a guide for the conduct of the sport. GSS is in the entertainment business. Drivers, Owners, Crew and GSS Staff cooperate to provide this exciting level of entertainment. All rules, race scheduling and structure, are designed and implemented to support a balance between competition and entertainment value. Drivers and crew are required to conduct themselves as professionals at all times. GSS may change any rule at any time in an effort to reduce the cost of racing, maintain equal competition, or improve safety.*

Procedural Rules: *It is the goal of Golden Sands Speedway management to maintain the safest possible racing conditions for all drivers, fans & track personnel. Only safety crews and wrecker crews are permitted on the track in the event of an accident. Pit crew members are not permitted on the track. Drivers are required to stay in their car in the event of an on-track incident. If a driver, for whatever reason, exits a car on the track during a caution period, the race will automatically be placed under a red flag and all cars will come to a complete stop. A driver may exit a car if requested by a safety crew member or if safety warrants in cases such as a fire or if car is upside down. Drivers that exit a car without permission, for whatever reason, are subject to fine and/or suspension at the discretion of track management. Drivers are also encouraged to drop the window nets after an accident as a sign to approaching safety crew members that they are ok, especially in a multicar situation to alert approaching safety crew members which drivers are in need of urgent attention.*

Rules Infraction Policy: *GSS Management may suspend or fine any driver, team member, or car owner for violation of track rules, policies, or procedures. Management has right to confiscate any item that is in violation of the rules.*



- 1. Car must be street legal less the lighting.**
- 2. You *must* remove all exterior trim and molding**
- 3. You *must* remove all glass except windshield.**
- 4. You *must* remove all flammable material except front seat and dash.**
- 5. You *must* have a single roll bar bolted or welded to the frame or floor, and bolted to the roof. Single roll bar in doors also recommended.**
Bumpers must be chained to the frame.
- 6. All airbags must be deactivated.**
- 7. If gas tank is ahead of rear axle it may remain in place. If gas tank is behind rear axle it must be replaced with a fuel cell or marine tank (max. 6.6 gal.) Must be secured by a minimum 1/8" x 1" steel strap with minimum 3/8" hardware.**
- 8. Vehicle Vin# must be left in car in stock location.**
- 9. 7" DOT tire only. Will be measured from inside to outside of tire. All tires must be of the same size and series. No Hoosier or Goodyear, or any other racing brand tires.**
- 10. Absolutely no slicks.**
- 11. No flex pipe on exhaust.**
- 12. 112" minimum wheelbase – 4 door sedans only.**
- 13. Five point harnesses mandatory.**
- 14. Absolutely no modification to engines – STOCK motors for the car's make and model ONLY!**
- 15. Steering and suspension must remain stock. No modifications. Ride attitude must be maintained.**
- 16. Car horn can remain intact and in working condition.**
- 17. 1/2" camber allowed. Measured with a carpenter square.**
- 18. No ballast may be added.**
- 19. You *must* have a riding mechanic (passenger).**
- 20. The gas pedal *must* be in the riding mechanic side only (out of reach of the driver).**
- 21. These stock cars should be able to drive down the road at the end of the night – less the lighting. (Street legal).**
- 22. There will be no duplicate numbers. The first car to register a number will get that number.**
- 23. All cars must be checked into the pits with driver and passenger by 7 pm, and must remain in the pit area.**
- 24. All official decisions are final.**
- 25. If it does not say you can do it – don't do it.**
- 26. These are cars you race, not racecars.**
- 27. All cars fall under general track rules of Golden Sands Speedway**
- 28. ALCOHOL/DRUGS Any driver with a detectable amount of alcohol or drugs present will not be allowed on the track. Drivers are responsible for the actions of their crew members.**
